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Face Coverings

Students will be expected to be wearing a face mask when they exit their vehicles and throughout various times of the school day (the safest and most effective mask is a surgical style mask). Should a student not have a mask, one will be provided for them. All masks must meet appropriate Christian standards and contain no wording. Face shields do not offer the layer of protection that a face mask provides. Therefore, a face shield cannot be used as a substitute for a face mask. Gaiters and bandanas are not acceptable.

Staff and Visitors

- All FLEC staff members and adult visitors will be required to wear face coverings in alignment with current state and local guidance, including when they are unable to be 6 feet away from others. Visitors who are under the age of 2 or whom a face covering would cause impairment due to an existing health condition or disability are excluded from this requirement.
